Regarding 'Washed Away/physically not available/Recovery done on incomplete works under Geo- MGNREGA- reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am to enclose herewith the copy of letter No. M-11011/2/2016-RE-III (part-I) 350900 dated 26th & 29th February, 2024 alongwith its enclosures received from Under Secretary (RD) to the Govt. of HP on the subject cited above and to inform you that an option has been provided in the NregaSoft to upload a certificate for assets of phase-I which are not available for geo tagging due to washed away in natural calamities. The copy of SOP is enclosed.

Beside this, the works which are not completed due to any other reasons or work not found on ground, districts are advised to initiate the recovery process and take disciplinary action against the erring officials before closing the works. For uploading the recovery certificate, a provision has also been made in NregaSoft.

Keeping in view the importance of the matter, you are, therefore, requested to intervene personally the matter so that remaining assets eligible for phase - I geo tagging may get geo- tagged by 31-10-2024 as per SoP. This is also applicable for phase-II (Stage -II & Stage -III) works.


Madam/Sir,

Subject: Completion of Geo-tagging of Assets covered under Geo-MGNREGA reg.
Madam/Sir,

As you all aware that phase-I Geo-MGNREGA was launched on 30th Nov.2016 by Hon'ble Union Minister of Rural Development. Subsequently phase-II of Geo-MGNREGA (3-stage Geo-tagging) has been started from 1st Nov. 2017. Accordingly, it has been decided that all the assets either completed or ongoing on 31st Oct. 2017 will be geo-tagged under phase-I (i.e. only one geo-tagging of assets after its completion).

2. The Phase-I geo-tagging was done by more than 7 years ago but still some completed assets of prior to 1st Nov, 2017 are pending for geo-tagging. This situation has been reviewed at various forum with States/UTs. In the Labor Budget (LB) meetings for FY 2023-24, it was decided to complete geo-tagging of all the assets (Geo-MGNREGA Phase-I) in priority by 31st March 2024.


3. A substantial progress has been made by your State in this regard. However, it has been observed that all assets of Geo-MGNREGA Phase-I have not been geo-tagged yet.

For Assets Washed Away due to natural calamities, State commissioner may close the asset by providing a certificate that the said assets are not available for geo-tagging due to natural calamities. For Assets not found on Ground, State/UT has to provide a certificate of recovery and disciplinary advise taken against the erring officials; before closing the assets. For uploading the certificate, a provision shall be made in NREGASoft by NIC-DRD as per the SoP(attached).

4. In view of above, it is, therefore, requested to intervene personally so that remaining assets eligible for phase-I geo-tagging may get geo-tagged by 31.03.2024 as per the SoP. This is also applicable for Phase-II (Stage 2 & Stage 3). States/UTs may submit the progress report to this Ministry after completion of the geo-tagging.
